My daughter Chase was diagnosed with **Osteosarcoma in Oct 2005 at age 7.**

She **began Chemo immediately for the remainder of that year**, struggling with nausea and vomiting (*vomiting up to 10 times during administration*).

In early 2006, Chase had surgery and her left knee and partial left femur were replaced. **We found out about Poly MVA shortly after surgery and began the suggested amount of Poly MVA for her weight.**

She went back on Chemo 3 weeks after surgery and the **immediate effect we noticed was her nausea/vomiting had subsided substantially.** She might vomit once during treatment or maybe not at all. **Her energy level was much higher....**the day after treatment she would take it easy and then **she would be back to 90%+ within a couple of days.**

Her *overall well being was much stronger* and she (keep in mind her age) grew 1/2" during her chemo. treatment which lasted a total of 9 months. This month will be our fifth year since diagnosis.

Five years later, **Chase is now 12 years old and still taking Ploy MVA** (maintenance dose of one teaspoon daily and CoQ10) and will continue to do so. **She is a very active young lady** who plays volley ball, cross country skis, golf's and this last spring ran track.

I feel that **Ploy MVA helped Chase have an easier time during Chemo but also helped her body repair itself after Chemo.**

Chase also had 4 surgeries total to adjust her left femur to accommodate for growth as well as months of physical therapy after. I feel that Poly MVA has helped her system recover each time and continues to keep her healthy.
