Wife diagnosed with Squamous cell carcinoma

In June of 2004 my wife was diagnosed with squamous cell carcinoma that had manifested itself in her neck. With an unknown primary she had a modified radical neck dissection and **chose not to do the radiation the doctors recommended. She instead found her way to Reno NV. and Dr. James Forsythe MD. He put her on poly and she used it for about 2 years.** She has quarterly checkups with her surgeon and NO cancer.

Gary is diagnosed with Prostate Cancer

In November of 2007 I ended up in emergency spinal surgery for what turned out to be **stage 4 Prostate cancer and had a large tumor removed from my lower spine.** My PSA was 1314.

Came home in a wheelchair and was using a walker. Had a catheter and really did not know if I would get any better. Well --- **it is now October 2008 - I am walking as I always did, use a catheter once a day to empty my bladder, my PSA is 0.5, my retests in June 2008 showed significant improvement in the bone and lymph node involvement.** I have some emotional issues but that may work itself out in time.

Oh did I forget to tell you? **I also went to Reno and Dr. Forsythe put me on Polymva and Salicinium**, a product that he is working with the FDA to get approved as a Cancer treatment.

I am quite sure **without polymva neither my wife nor I would be here to tell you this story.** Thank you polymva and your wonderful staff - you have blessed our lives.

Spoke to Elma and **Gary and he is doing very well. His PSA is down to 1.4.** Gary said, that after the surgery, his PSA came down and his **cat scan results showed significant improvement.** They are very optimistic and **very happy they found Poly.**

3-27-2009

Spoke to Mrs. Thomas. She says **Gary is doing great** and she said **his doctors are even surprised how well he is doing.**

4-06-2012

Spoke to Gary and he is not doing well. **His PSA has shot up** and the **Lupron he was on is no longer working for him.** He called Dr. Forsythe's office, they gave him a protocol that they would use on him however it would cost \$31,000.00 dollars and **he told me he can't afford it** they just don't have any money. His doctor is going to try and get him into a clinical trial testing something called Orteronel Tak 700 this will be the third trial on the drug. **Gary is very down and told me he dosen't even feel like eating** and just doesn't know what to do.

7-02-2013

Spoke to Gary. He **wanted to let me know his PSA seems to be holding.** His doctor gave him a **choice of three meds or do nothing at this time.** Gary has chosen **to only take Poly** and other Supplements.
