In **December of 2009**, I was **diagnosed with stage 3 uterus cancer**. I want to give people hope that are fighting cancer. My Doctors had a meeting about me and said I was a **very sick lady**, with **very low red blood levels**.

They **started me on radiation** after my operation. It was at this time a **friend told me about PolyMVA**. Soon after starting it, **my blood count went up to normal**. I was **never tired during radiation** and was able to continue with life as normal.

My friends and family were shocked at how well I was doing because **I did not look sick and remained active**. At my 1 year checkup my **doctor said I am doing well**.

My message to other cancer patients is that when we are losing all grips no matter what we are going through the Lord is our stronghold.

**2-05-2010**

I spoke with Carol. She is currently taking 4 tsp. of the poly while **undergoing radiation treatments**. She said she is **feeling good, not tired and can eat**. Her Doctor has told her that he **would like her to do chemo**. She wanted to know if we have patients who have only taken Poly and not chemo. I told her we have support members that have done a combination of both. Some of our Survivors have **taken Poly MVA and chemo/radiation** and some **Poly by itself**, usually after they have tried chemo before or are told that chemo is not option.

**2-18-2010**

I called Carol and she is **still doing the same and feeling good**. She is still **receiving radiation treatments** and will undergo a total of 28 treatments.

**6-14-2012**

Carol is **cancer free**. She takes PMVA once a week now.

**1-30-2013**

Carol says **she is doing really well** and is only taking Poly MVA once or twice a week.

**1-09-2014**

Followed up with Carol. She said that she went in for her **check up in December and she is doing well**.

**5-23-2015**

Talked to Carol. She said that she now only takes as a **maintenance dose of Poly MVA** every now and then.
